

Because we process personal information which concerns you, we'd like to provide you with relevant information about this matter. We are obliged to do so by the provisions of the General Data Protection Regulation, which we briefly call the GDPR.

Who is the data administrator?

Farmbnb.com is operated by IT Incubator sp. z o.o. and we have our headquarters at Berneńska 16c street, 03-976 in Warsaw. You can contact us by phone: +48 22 354 77 93 or by e-mail: bok@farmbnb.pl.

For what purposes will we process the data?

The purposes for which we will process personal data are:

- Conclusion and performance of the contract,
- Mediation in explaining disputes arising between you and other users of our website,
- Prevention of possible scams.

On what legal basis we process your personal data?

We have two legal bases:

- The first legal basis is art. 6 par. 1 lit. b) GDPR. It says that the processing of your personal data is legal, if it is necessary to perform the contract to which you are a party, or to take action on your request, before concluding this contract;
- The second basis is art. 6 par. 1 lit. f) GDPR, which shows that we may process personal data if it is necessary for the purposes of legally justified interests pursued by us or a third party.

The exception is situations in which your interests or your fundamental rights and freedoms that require the protection of personal data have an overriding nature in relation to these interests.

How do we justify the above-mentioned "our legitimate interest"?

The motive for this interest is recital (47) in the prefix GDPR. It says, among other things, that the legitimate interest of the administrator is to process personal data absolutely necessary to prevent fraud.

Where do we get your data from?

The data we process is from two sources:

- Directly from you - providing these data is voluntary, but we make the conclusion of the contract conditional upon your submission;
- From the website www.farmbnb.com/en/, where we analyze the number of visitors to it, the number of questions about the availability of services offered by you and the number of initial reservations made through the site.

What categories of personal data will we process?

We will process so-called regular data.

Who can be the recipient of personal data?

The data concerning you may be disclosed to our employees, state authorities operating under the law and:

- To entities processing data on our behalf, acting on the basis of special data processing entrustment agreements;
- Website users who make a deposit by expressing their will to use your services (they will receive your contact details from us);
- Banks or other institutions through which we will be financially accountable;
- Post, couriers, e-mail service providers, providers of mobile telephony services - to the extent that results from their communication;
- Part of the data will be made public (about which data will be decided by yourself when managing the Host Profile on our website).

How long will we store data?

We will keep the data for a period in which it will be necessary to achieve the aforementioned goals:

- Accounting data - 5 years or more, if necessary for the implementation of the aforementioned goals;
- Data included on the website - as long as we remain partners, and your Host Profile on the site will be active;
- Data processed in order to protect against fraud or to resolve disputes - until the time of possible claims of our or a third party.

What rights do you have?

Due to the fact that we process data concerning you, you have the following rights:

- The right to request access to your data from us;
- The right to demand rectification of data;
- The right to request deletion of data;
- The right to request processing restrictions;
- The right to object to data processing;
- The right to data transfer;
- The right to lodge a complaint to the supervisory body (in Poland it is the Office for Personal Data Protection).

Will we make automatic decisions about you?

The data processing planned by us always takes into account the significant human participation. Even in situations where the processing is done with the help of a machine, it will not make decisions that can seriously affect you. We leave people to make such decisions.
