

Because we intend to process personal data that concerns you, we provide you with relevant information about this matter. We are obliged to do so by the provisions of the General Data Protection Regulation, which we briefly call the GDPR.

Who is the data administrator?

Farmbnb.com is operated by IT Incubator sp. z o.o. and we have our headquarters at ul. Berneńska 16c street, 03-976 in Warsaw. You can contact us by phone: +48 22 354 77 93 or by e-mail: bok@farmbnb.pl.

For what purposes will we process the data?

The purposes of personal data processing result from the provisions of the Regulations and they are:

- Keeping an Account on the Website;
- Adding Host's ratings or feedback about the Host on the Website;
- Submitting your question to the Host and providing you with his answer;
- Possibility to pay the deposit to the host;
- Possibility to make a Booking on the Website;
- Provision of the Newsletter Service; and
- Mediation in explaining disputes arising between you and other users of our site.

On what legal basis we process your personal data?

We process data on the following legal bases:

- Art. 6 par. 1 lit. a) RODO, where it is stated that the processing of personal data is legal if the data subject has consented to such processing for one or more specific purposes;
- Art. 6 par. 1 lit. b) RODO, where it is stated that the processing of personal data is lawful, if it is necessary for the performance of the contract to which the data subject is party or take action at the request of the data subject, before concluding agreement;
- Art. 6 par. 1 lit. f) RODO, where it is stated that the processing of personal data is legal, if it is necessary for the purposes resulting from legally justified interests pursued by us or a third party. The only exception is situations in which your interests or your fundamental rights and freedoms that require the protection of personal data have an overriding nature in relation to these interests;

How do we justify the above-mentioned "our legitimate interest"?

The rationale for this interest is the provision in recital (47) of the RODO preamble. It says, among other things, that "the legitimate interest of the administrator involved in the case is also the processing of personal data absolutely necessary to prevent fraud" and "for acting in a legitimate way.

The processing of personal data for direct marketing purposes can be considered as an interest. "

Where do we get your data from?

We collect data from you using the forms on the page.

What categories of personal data will we process?

We will process so-called regular data.

Who can be the recipient of personal data?

The data concerning you may be disclosed to our employees, state authorities operating under the law and:

- To entities processing data on our behalf, acting on the basis of a special contract;
- The host you are addressing the question to;
- Your e-mail service provider, to which you will receive a response,
- The operator of online payments.

How long will we store data?

- We will store data related to your account on the Website until this account is deleted;
- We will keep accounting data for 5 years or longer - for the period necessary to achieve the above objectives.

What rights do you have?

Due to the fact that we process data concerning you, you have the following rights:

- The right to request access to your data from us;
- The right to demand rectification of data;
- The right to request deletion of data;
- The right to request processing restrictions;
- The right to object to data processing;
- The right to data transfer;
- The right to file a complaint to the supervisory body (in Poland it is the Office for Personal Data Protection).

Will we make automatic decisions about you?

The data processing planned by us always takes into account the significant human participation. Even in situations where the processing is done with the help of a machine, it will not make decisions that can seriously affect you. We leave people to make such decisions.
